

University of California, Public Notice Process under HEERA (UC-CNA/Registered Nurse Unit)

The Higher Education Employer–Employee Relations Act, which governs collective bargaining of higher education employers in the state of California, requires that the University as the employer provide notice to the public before it begins negotiations with an exclusive representative.

The current Registered Nurse collective bargaining agreement between the University of California (UC), and the California Nurses Association (CNA), provides for successor contract negotiations in 2017. Systemwide bargaining may begin following completion of the public notice meetings scheduled below.

The University will convene initial public notice meetings on April 5, 2017 and April 19, 2017. Both meetings will take place from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm in room 1015, at 300 Lakeside Drive, 10th floor, Oakland, CA, 94612. Copies of initial bargaining proposals will be available at the meetings.
