1 The *Ex Parte* Application of Plaintiff The Regents of the University of California (“University”)
2 for a Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause re Preliminary Injunction (CCP §§ 526,
3 527) came before this Court on June 7, 2024.

4 Having read the application, the memoranda and the declarations filed by the parties, and having
5 heard argument of counsel, the Court finds that good cause has been shown to grant the University’s *Ex*
6 *Parte* application.

7 **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED,**


8 1. That Defendant UAW, their agents, employees, representatives, officers, organizers,
9 committee persons, stewards, members, and all corporations, unincorporated associations, and natural
10 persons acting in concert and participation with any of them, be enjoined and restrained from all strike
11 activities while the no-strike clauses in the CBAs are in effect;

12 2. That a Temporary Restraining Order be granted, enjoining and restraining Defendant
13 UAW, its agents, employees, representatives, officers, organizers, committee persons, stewards, and
14 members, and all persons acting in concert with them or any of them, until the hearing upon an Order to
15 Show Cause, from doing or causing to be done any of the acts prayed in paragraph 1 of this prayer to be
16 enjoined or restrained; and

17 ~~3. That upon the hearing of the Order to Show Cause, a Preliminary Injunction be granted~~
18 ~~restraining Defendants UAW its agents, employees, representatives, officers, organizers, committee~~
19 ~~persons, stewards, and members, and all persons acting in concert with them or any of them, from doing~~
20 ~~or causing to be done any of the acts or things prayed in paragraph 1 of this prayer to be enjoined or~~
21 ~~restrained. For general damages incurred by the University that were caused by UAW’s strike;~~
