I write to you on behalf of the members of the K-2 bargaining unit at UCSF pursuant to Article 25 of the collective bargaining agreement. With this letter we notify UCSF of our intent to negotiate a successor Agreement. We intend to propose changes to the following sections:

Article 1 Recognition and Definitions: We seek to expand our jurisdiction at more campuses and intend to propose options for doing so.

Article 3 No Strike/No Lockout: The University has experienced several strikes that have impacted jobsites, and we intend to modify this section to provide more clarity to bargaining unit members.

Article 6 Union Security: We intend to propose clean-up language.

Article 18 Benefits Coverage: We intend to propose maintenance of benefits language.

Article 19 Wages: We intend to propose increases to the salary range and differentials.

Article 27 Safety Shoes: We intend to expand this section to address costs and eligible use.

New Section: We are considering expanding access to the training centers of our respective local unions and there may be a fiscal impact to this proposal.
